MARCH MEETING MINUTES

Announcements

Bob Lucas, President, welcomed everyone to the meeting. There was one new member attending.

There are plants for our raffle, donated by the Co-op. Tickets are 1 for \$1 or 3 for \$2, available at the table at the back.

The Executive will decide after this meeting the location of future meetings., i.e. either LutherCare Village or John Dolan School. Members will need to check the next newsletter or the SOS website for the location of the April meeting.

The next meeting will be the AGM and Silent Auction to be held on April 22, at which time the 2018-2019 elections for the Executive will be held. The silent auction is a major fund raiser for the SOS. Members may bring orchids and orchid related material for the auction. They may designate that 100% or 50% of the proceeds go to the SOS. Family and friends are invited to attend as well. There will be a regular "Show & Tell" as well.

Gardenscape will be March 23-25. Volunteer passes are available for pick up today. The SOS booth is in Hall D-E, near the north end of the building. Those bringing plants are to drop them off on Thursday, March 22, 3:30 - 5:30pm. Plants should be groomed and staked, and the owner's name put on the bottom of the pot. Plants can be picked up after the show, between 5:00 and 5:30pm on Sunday.

The SOS will be participating in the Orchid Society of Alberta Show held on April 6-8. Information about pre-orders from vendors is available in the March newsletter. The plant registrations need to be submitted by March 31 so send information to Bob Lucas by March 30, including plant name, parentage and class in which it's to be entered. Ask Bob if you have any questions about registration. If you're unsure about whether or not a plant will be ready for the show include it in your list; it's easier to remove it from the list than to add it later. All plants to be submitted to the show must travel with

Bob due to space limitations for the return trip. Plants are to be dropped off at Bob's house, 519 Mendel Terrace, on April 4 from 6:30 - 8:30pm. Pickup is on April 9 from 6:30 - 8:30pm.

Pat Randall reported that the resource table will have available Orchiata bark, possibly by the April meeting. It is produced from New Zealand *Pinus radiata* bark, and has been made available recently in Canada. The bark is pH balanced by a lime bath prior to packaging and no pre-treatment is required before potting. The bark lasts about 3 years, so one does not need to repot as frequently.

Treats today were provided by Cheryl Grummett, Marge Kowalchuk, Pat Randall and Mercedes Montgomery. Coffee will not be available today, but water and pop is available.
